Action Plan

Business Research Collaboration



Supports manufacturers to modernise, adopt new technologies, become more productive and create more jobs by co-funding capital investments and associated reskilling.

There are two streams of funding:

- an estimated \$20 million for grants between \$50,000 to \$100,000 for small scale technology and efficiency investments. <u>Grantee contribution is 1:1</u>
- an estimated **\$30 million for larger grants between \$100,000 to \$1 million** to support transformative investments in technologies and processes. <u>Grantee contribution is 3:1</u>

The maximum grant period is 2 years.

Manufacturing Modernisation Fund

Merit Criteria

To be competitive you must score highly against all of the merit criteria.

Merit Criterion 1

• The extent that your project will improve your manufacturing competitiveness and lead to job growth (40 points)

Merit Criterion 2

• Capacity, capability and resources to deliver the project (40 points)

Merit Criterion 3

• Impact of the grant funding on your project (20 points)
