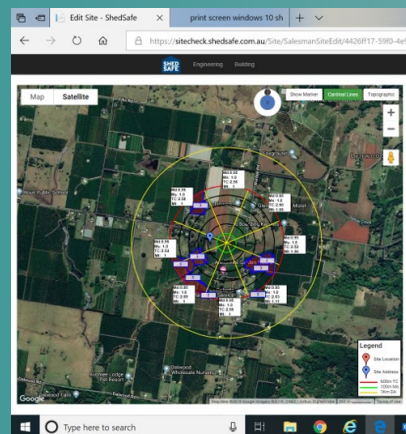
Key Presenter
