The Victorian Government QR Code Service has been developed in consultation with industry, and connects seamlessly with Victoria's contact tracing system.


Additionally, venues must make reasonable efforts to provide or use alternative record-keeping systems for people who do not have access to, or cannot use, a personal mobile phone to check in.

It's important that businesses ensure clients, customers and visitors check in on arrival.
