A one-off job fabricating and installing handrails at the Loy Yang A and Yallourn power station projects in the 1980s has grown into a prospering steel fabrication business for Stable Engineering Services owner John Buhagiar. The Victoria-based company now does infrastructure work nationwide, with transmission towers and bespoke fabrication a speciality. John, who employs anywhere from six up to more than 100 people depending on the size of the project, is currently tendering for solar and wind farm projects. Stable's specialty skills include high pressure parts work, process plant installation and commissioning, pipe spooling, tank fabrication, rotating equipment, and transmission tower design and manufacture. The company recently completed 44 bogmats at 450 tonne for a Vic Government Big Build project comprising more than 20kms of submerged arc welding, and tenders for work in the defence supply industry. InfraBuild path to mental health care

Even though mental health issues are prevalent, it is one of the most neglected forms of health in the world today. Metal Musings recognises World Mental Health Day today (October 10) by shining a light on this year's inaugural ASI Steel Sustainability Awards winner of the company or project initiative – large business category: InfraBuild's program <u>The road to sustainability through good health and safety</u>. The InfraBuild program encourages ongoing improvement in workplace health and safety including mental health through targeted social, environmental, sustainable and economic outcomes. CEO and executive director of InfraBuild Francisco Irazusta says no task, target or activity is more important than the safety of our team. "At InfraBuild, we take psychosocial safety just as seriously as physical safety." In 2020, the company began a transformative journey towards a better workplace culture by producing a comprehensive roadmap known as the WRIB (We are InfraBuild) Safe Way. Underpinning this are four strategic pillars: enabling performance, critical incident prevention, interdependent safety culture, and fit for work and fit for life. "We've been on a journey to reshape our safety culture since 2020. It is about the behaviour, it's our approach to safety that is most transformative," Irazusta said. The company has reported a 300 per cent increase in the number of interventions from 2021 to 2023. "We did this by giving our team the tools and the training, 95 per cent of employees have been trained in our behavioural safety program, Safety Connect." Internal leaders delivered the Safety Connect program to all levels of the organisation across a series of face-to-face seminars. An automated electronic report is sent to all leaders daily.
